**About the camp**

The **W**omen **I**n **T**echnology **S**ummer camp is for young women who have just completed their sophomore, junior, or senior years in high school. The camp is designed to introduce young women to the fields of computer science and engineering technology. The camp includes housing, 3 meals a day, all necessary books and supplies for scheduled sessions, and t-shirts.

Participants in the camp will arrive on campus on Sunday afternoon. After checking into the dorm, they will meet the faculty, resident advisors, and student assistants for dinner.

On Monday morning, participants begin sessions that will include creating virtual worlds using Alice, engineering technology, critical thinking, and software skills. Sessions will run from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM with breaks and lunches.

Saturday will wrap up with a half-day of sessions followed by a farewell lunch.

Participants who successfully complete the camp and graduated from high school in 2009 will be given first consideration for \$1,000 scholarships to attend TAMUCC.
